Grade 12 pupils are quickly approaching the final stages of High School with the Prelim exams and Final exams right around the corner. Equip yourself to be ready for those two exams as well as the various SBA tasks that are scheduled. Remember your futures are in your hands.

Curriculum news

1. Learners in Grade 12 tend not to study Grade 11 (and sometimes Grade 10) work as well. This is just as important. The final examinations will include Grade 11 work in subjects. Speak to your Educator.
2. Past Papers should be used to study. Pupils need to get used to how the questions are asked. Past Paper exemplars are on the GDE website otherwise you can buy a book at PNA. Speak to your educator first because they might be able to give Past Papers electronically.
3. Irregularities during exams will be dealt with. Remember that you can get 0 for the Examination just because you were involved in an irregularity.
4. Absent during exams must be accompanied by a doctor's note or any other note that will denote a valid reason. The learner can be awarded a 0 for the specific part of Exam if no note is received.

Parents please be reminded that the FINAL date for submissions of 2020 re-registration forms is **31 May 2019**. If these forms are not returned it is noted that your child will not be returning to Wordsworth for education space in 2020.

School Uniform


