Payment Options:



- ❖ **Grade 12 learners (2019):** The amount of R12000 is payable in 8 equal instalments of R1500.00 per month from January to August 2019.
- ❖ **Paid in full by 31 March 2019:** less 10% discount.
- ❖ **Paid in full by 30 May 2019:** less 5% discount.
