| ❖ Paid in full by 31 January 2018: | less 20% discount |
| ❖ Paid in full by 31 March 2018: | less 10% discount |
| ❖ Paid in full by 30 May 2018: | less 5% discount |

If the school is closed on the 7th of the month, the school fee must be paid the day that the school re-opens. Alternatively, you may deposit the money into the school's bank account, either by a direct deposit, internet transfer or by installing a stop order on your account to credit our account. **Please note:** We do not accept cheques and do not have a debit order system nor card facilities.
